

Abstract supply list.

This is an addendum to the supply list we've been using

1. Colored craft tissue paper
2. Rubbing (isopropyl) alcohol
3. Any type of thin cotton fabric (you can use some old thin clothing scraps or visit JoAnn Fabrics & Crafts. They have an extensive selection of small inexpensive collections of unusual prints. Better to do this **AFTER** you decide on the emotions you wish to express in your painting and then can choose a fabric that may be a good fit for what you're thinking).
4. Water based markers such as Crayola
5. Plastic wrap (Saran Wrap)
6. Wax crayons
7. **HEAVY** acrylic gel medium (you most likely already have this as it was listed on the original supply list. We will be using a substantial amount of it on the abstract painting so very important that you have it. Also, in some instances we'll be pressing material and tissue paper onto the canvas with our hands so you may want a set of plastic gloves. Your choice. I don't use gloves but if you don't you'll want to wash your hands within about 10 minutes of finishing with the medium).
